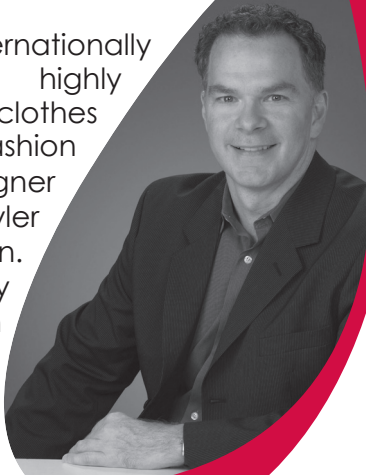

## HEALTH ALLIANCE PLANNING UPDATE

Progress continues on the integration efforts across the Health Alliance System. During the past eight months, the Patient Accounting and Information Systems Departments have been integrated. The Patient Accounting consolidation occurred in the spring, and like the Finance Department integration, all staff are now located at Grant Avenue. In the past few months the talent and resources of the Information Systems Departments of all three hospitals have been combined, as well as the Case Management Departments of both Benedictine and The Kingston Hospitals.

There are a number of key areas of focus regarding clinical areas that have a strong potential for increasing volume when services are combined, and where sharing specialized clinical resources is key to maintaining a high quality of care. As such, detailed planning and renovations have taken place for combining Sleep Lab, Wound Care, Outpatient PT/OT/Speech, Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, Cardiac Cath, and Obstetrics (but not until Foxhall Ambulatory Surgery Center is completed.)
