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**Mountainside Residential Care Center
named 'Leader in LGBT Healthcare Equality' for fourth time**

MARGARETVILLE, N.Y., May 26, 2016 -- For the fourth consecutive year, Mountainside Residential Care Center in Margaretville was named a national "Leader in LGBT Healthcare Equality."

The Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing home, providing comprehensive skilled nursing 24 hours a day -- part of HealthAlliance of the Hudson Valley -- received the honor from the Human Rights Campaign Foundation, the educational arm of the nation's largest lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender civil rights organization.

The foundation gives the distinction to U.S. healthcare facilities that meet LGBT-inclusive benchmarks contained in the foundation's national Healthcare Equality Index 2016. The index is an annual national survey that encourages equitable and inclusive care policies and practices for LGBT patients, visitors and employees.

The designation Mountainside received is based on healthcare facilities' patient nondiscrimination policies, equal visitation policies, employment nondiscrimination policies and training for employees in LGBT patient-centered care.

"At Mountainside and at all HealthAlliance facilities, we are committed to providing a welcoming and affirming healthcare experience to everyone, including our LGBT patients and families," said HealthAlliance President and CEO David Scarpino.

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“We are honored Mountainside is recognized for the fourth consecutive year as a leader in LGBT healthcare equality, and we at HealthAlliance will continue to work hard to ensure our LGBT patients and their families are treated with the same compassion and understanding we seek to provide to everyone who trusts us with their medical care,” Scarpino said.

HealthAlliance Human Resources Administrative Director Heidi Rosborough added: “We recognize the importance of a leader in healthcare also being a leader in healthcare equality. We are dedicated to making HealthAlliance a fully inclusive place to work and seek care, and we are pleased to see our efforts being recognized.”

To be named a leader in LGBT Healthcare Equality, Mountainside met key criteria, including resident and employee nondiscrimination policies that specifically mention sexual orientation and gender identity, a guarantee of equal visitation for same-sex partners and parents, and LGBT health education for key staff members.

The Healthcare Equality Index offers healthcare facilities unique and powerful resources designed to help provide equal care to a long-overlooked group of patients, as well as assistance in complying with new regulatory requirements and access to high-quality staff training.
